



Two Brothers Software Theatrical EKG Simulation

What is the Theatrical EKG Simulator (EKS – 1000)? The EKS-1000 software was designed to provide an EKG tracing on a monitor or screen for theatrical purposes. Developed to mimic some basic EKG tracings to provide a realistic simulation without having to spend thousands of dollars on software designed for medical professionals when it is not necessary. Nothing included herein is designed to be replacement for medical training or diagnosis by licensed medical practitioners.

Using the EKS-1000 is very simple. The program is designed to run in 800 x 600 mode to ensure that the view does not change with different computers. You can use the EKS through an external TV or a computer monitor with the correct hardware. This guide cannot be used as a guide to determine what hardware will be needed.

The EKS-1000 can be run in addition to running a light board or sound board, as it is not complicated, the key list enclosed can be print out for easy reference.

The following is a quick synopsis on how to use the program. When starting the EKS-1000 Press the “S” key, this starts the EKG engine and readies your system with all of the data it will need to run the program. You will see the leads are off until you select a rhythm.

To start the simulation you will need to pick a starting rhythm. The rhythms are on the number key pad on the top of the key board. Use the number 1 above the tab key to start the number 1 EKG, not the number 1 on the number pad. The number pad is not functional during the simulation. This is to prevent from accidental pressing of the wrong key during the simulation.

The rhythms are designated in 2 areas. The numbers on the left of the keyboard are rhythms that are generally life sustaining, and to the right (6 and greater) are not life sustaining. You can find out more information on the specific rhythms elsewhere on the internet.

Entering a simulated patient name is as easy as pressing the F5 key, entering the name and pressing the Escape Key. You may chose to enter a simulated room name or other name.

Changing rhythms during the simulation is as easy as pressing the corresponding number keys. The function keys also serve as rhythm modifiers. If your EKG tracing cannot be seen, press F2 to toggle through the widths. Either 1px, 2px or 3px width can be selected with the F2 key. Increase the size (vertical size) by pressing the F3 key. You should note that some rhythms look 'blocky' when doing this and this should be done cautiously. Also, you can decrease the vertical size by pressing the F4 key. Some rhythms when slowed down look much better 'scrunched' to tiny size using the F4 key. You will have to experiment to see what you like.

ST elevation occurs when there is either cardiac ischemia or other cardiac event occurring. Simulate an increased ST segment by pressing F7. Decrease the ST elevation by pressing the F5 key. Note this only works with rhythms 1,2,3

and 4. Your ST elevation settings transfer between these rhythms. You can set ST elevation without being set in one of these rhythms.

Premature Ventricular Contractions (PVC's) occur when the heart is irritated. There are two types of PVC's that you can select from in the EKS-1000, the F10 and F11 PVC. These PVC's can be coupled (back to back) or can be ran into short or long runs. All PVC's will stop all other rhythms for a short duration, although the refractory period for the F11 PVC is longer. The F10 and F11 PVC's can both be used together, but not at the same time.

When the heart does not work correctly, it may need to be defibrillated. The EKS-1000 simulates the EKG tracing of the electrical shock. Rhythms that require electrical shock in the EKS-1000 would be rhythms 8 and 9. The simulated defibrillation F12 can be used to simulate an electrical shock being delivered. Once you have pressed F12, there will be time in the interim to select another rhythm. If you want to change the rhythm, press the new rhythm key quickly after pressing F12, this rhythm will show up after about 2 1/2 seconds.

If your simulated patient pulls their electrode leads off the EKG tracing will cease. Simulate this by pressing the delete key.

EKS – 1000, Two Brothers Software Key Code List

S - Load simulation and start EKS-1000. It is important to know that the simulation software cannot start without this key.

↑ - Activate mouse wheel rate change or increase the rhythm's rate (mouse wheel up)

↓ - decrease the rhythm's rate (mouse wheel down)

Rhythms (*Best Viewed Rates at normal size*)

1 – Simulated Sinus Rhythm (*54- 172*)

2 – Simulated Wide Complex Tachy (*118-269*)

3 – Simulated Sinus Brady (*27- 75*)

4 – Simulated Atrial Fibrillation (*all rates*)

6 – Simulated Agonal Rhythm (*no rate shown*)

7 – Simulated CHB No vent response (*no rate shown*)

8 – Simulated VT (*143 – over 300*)

9 – Simulated VF (*no rate shown*)

0 – Simulated Asystole (*all okay*)

[Delete Key] - Pull leads off

F1 – Exit EKS - 1000

F2 – Change width of EKG tracing (1,2,or 3 pixel width)

F3 – Make EKG tracking LARGER

F4 – Make EKG tracking Smaller

F5 – Enter a name, press escape to leave

F7 – Increase ST elevation (for rhythms 1-4)

F8 – Decrease ST elevation (for rhythms 1-4)

F10 – Simulated PVC (type I)

F11 – Simulated PVC (type II)

F12 – Simulated Defibrillation (electrical current)

Troubleshooting

If you are having problems with the EKS-1000 here are some quick tips on making the program work better.

My simulated EKG is not in full screen mode OR, I do not want to run in full screen mode.

Your computer during the installation may have altered the running the program in full screen mode. Open My Computer and find the file EKS1000.exe in the “C:2bs/eks1000/” folder. Right click and select properties. Click on the tab labeled COMPATABILITY. Select Run in 640x480 mode OR deselect it, depending on which you would like.

My Simulated EKG runs to fast or too slow.

Your computer’s processor speed may affect how the tracing is shown. Open my computer and navigate to the “C:2bs/eks1000/” folder. Open the systemspeedtrim.txt file. The default system speed trim is 10. Change to larger numbers to slow down, or smaller numbers to speed up depending on your computer speed. You may also use this to slow down the tracing if that is your need.
